Attention All Employers

RE: CLARIFICATION AND CONFIRMATION OF COMMUNICATION AS SENT OUT BY THE NBCPSS

The National Bargaining Council for the Private Security Sector (“NBCPSS”), has embarked to communicate with all employers within the sector over the last couple of weeks.

Some of these communiques was sent in error to employers and therefore might have caused confusion and thus the NBCPSS would like to reiterate and clarify:

1. All Employers within the scope of the Council is obligated to register and contribute levies as per the Main Collective Agreement and the Levy Agreement (copy available on www.nbcps.org.za).
2. All Employees employed as security officers that fall within the scope of the Main Collective Agreement (copy available on www.nbcps.org.za) is obligated to register with the preferred Medical Cover supplier- Affinity Health.

Should the employee already belong to a medical aid/ medical insurance, employers should apply for exemption.

We trust the above to clear up any unnecessary confusion caused.
